LAST MINUTE INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS

We thank you for your registration at FCCat. You will find below some useful information for your stay with us.

• Venue to Azureva center :

The conference will take place at the holiday center:

AZUREVA FREJUS, 1943 rue des combattants d'Afrique du Nord, BP 109 - 83608 Fréjus.

WIFI is provided in the registration hall and in the bar, not in rooms nor in the lecture room (for exhibitors, note that exhibition booths will be placed in the bar).

A room is booked for you from Monday to Friday. If you wish to book an additional night from Sunday 22 to Monday 23, it might be possible at your own expense, please first contact us (fccat@sciencesconf.org) before booking at Azureva, so that we can give you your room number.

Access:

- *By plane*

Nice Airport at about one hour by road from the Azureva center.

On Monday 23, a free shuttle service is proposed from Nice Airport, departure 1:00 pm, then 1:15 pm, then 1:30 pm just at the boarder of **Terminal 2** ("Parking Bus" different from "Gare routière"). A free airport shuttle service exists from terminal 1 to terminal 2. François Jérôme and Grégory Chatel will be placed at important places to guide you with the FCCat logo. You can contact François Jérôme (+33 6 37 11 37 56) in case of problem.

On Friday 27, a free shuttle service is proposed from Azureva to the Nice Airport, departure 1:00 pm from the Azureva center (arrival at the airport expected around 2:00 pm).

Regular buses connect the Nice Airport to the center of Fréjus at specific hours, see <http://www.nice.aeroport.fr/var/anca/storage/original/application/6986c2e0ef28849d9873fe443c2e06f5.pdf>. Note however that the Azureva center is not in the center of Fréjus. City buses (lines 1 and 1bis, <http://www.agglobus-cavem.com/>) ensure the connection at certain hours, stop called “Village Vacances”.

- *By train*

The nearest TGV station is Saint Raphaël-Valescure (connections from Lyon, Marseille, Paris, Nice).

On Monday 23, a free shuttle service is proposed for arrivals at TGV Saint-Raphaël Valescure train station, departure 1:30 pm from the bus station close to the train station (“Gare routière Intercommunale”, Avenue Victor Hugo). The number of the gate will be given 48 hours before. Hélène Olivier-Bourbigou and Franck Launay will be placed at important places to guide you with the FCCat logo. You can contact Hélène Olivier-Bourbigou (+33 6 21 68 83 40) in case of problem.



On Friday 27, a free shuttle service is proposed from Azureva to TGV Saint-Raphaël Valescure train station, departure 1:00 pm from the Azureva center (arrival at the train station expected at 1:30 pm).

City buses (lines 1 and 1bis, <http://www.agglobus-cavem.com/>) ensure the connection between Saint-Raphaël and the Azureva center at certain hours, stop called “Village Vacances”.

Regional trains also exist between Nice Ville and Fréjus, please see <http://www.voyages-sncf.com/>. Note however that the Azureva center is not in the center of Fréjus. Again, city buses (line 1bis, <http://www.agglobus-cavem.com/>) ensure the connection at certain hours from the Fréjus train station, stop called “Village Vacances”.

- ***By car :***

The center is 3.5 km from Fréjus city center, 30 km from Cannes, 60 km from Nice. Access is possible through Highway A8, exit n°38, see the small map.

• Information for lecturers

• Information for poster presenters

The posters (A0 size, portrait) will be presented in two separate poster sessions:

- session 1 on Monday-Tuesday, posters can be installed right from the beginning of the conference and shall be removed on Tuesday afternoon at the end of the afternoon break.
- session 2 on Wednesday – Thursday, posters can be installed from Wednesday morning and shall be removed on Thursday afternoon at the end of the afternoon break.
